

How to Make The 3D Easter Egg Card

Step by Step Tutorial

This 3D Easter Egg Card is quick and easy to make is very unique!

1. Using card stock, print out the:

- egg shapes
- the card front
- the card back.

2. Fold the card front in half, along the dotted line. Use the flat side of a pair of scissors to make the crease sharp and smooth.

3. Using small, sharp scissors, cut out each egg shape.

4. Glue one of the egg shapes on the card. (I used a glue stick.)

5. Fold all of the other eggs in half, using the same method to crease the eggs in half

6. Apply glue across the egg that is on the card.

7. Now, place two egg halves on top of it, carefully lining up the edges. Press down and allow a bit of time for the glue to dry.

8. Repeat the same process

- Apply glue on top...
- then place another set of eggs on the top

9. Continue until you run out of eggs. (Glue the last two eggs together.)

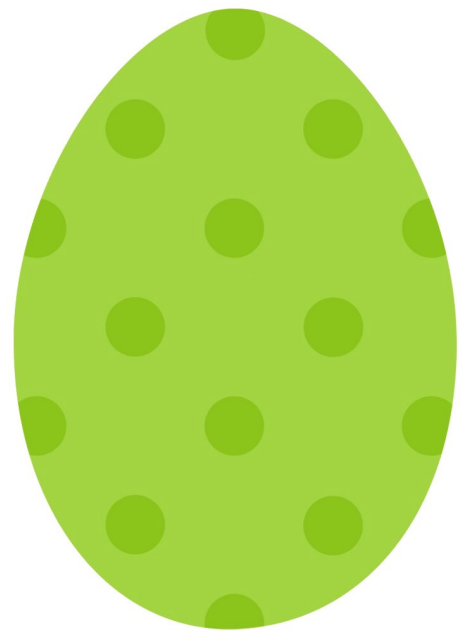
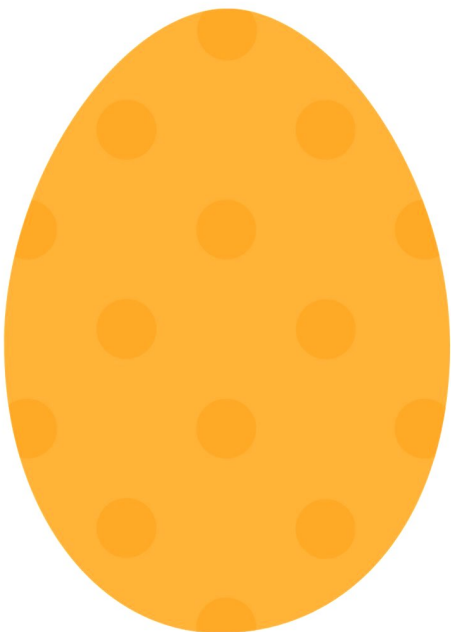
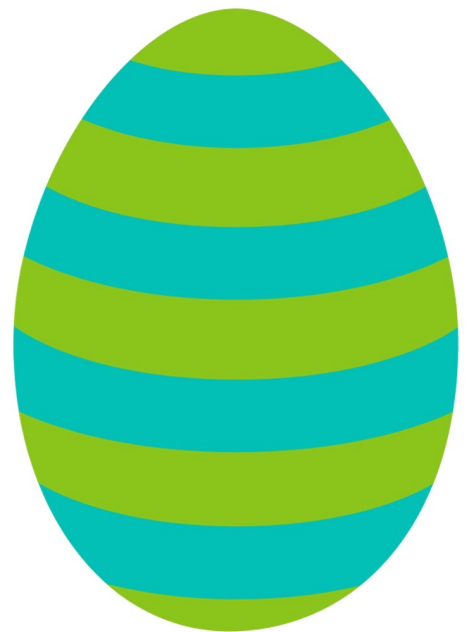
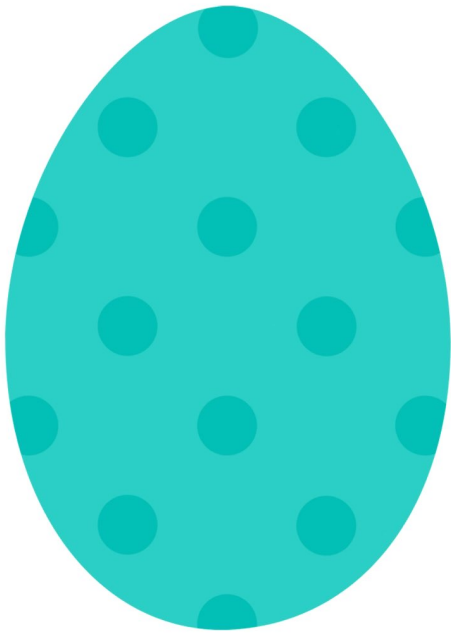
10. Next, make the inside of the card. Cut the card along the dotted line.

11. Glue the inside of the card to the inside of the card front that you just made.

12. Sign you name, if desired!
