Kit Instructions

Thank you for purchasing the **Pizza Party Theme** Babysitter Activity Kit! To help you get started, we've put together a few instructions for you. If you have any questions, don't hesitate to contact me at cheryl@momsandmunchkins.ca.

Coloring Page

Dig out those scissors, crayons and markers and get ready to be creative! In this package you'll find a pizza crust waiting to be topped with pizza sauce, your favorite toppings and cheese! Color these in on your own or use the page of pizza toppings to color, cut and glue. (Glue sticks would be great here.) Get as creative as you'd like with it and make your most favorite pie ever!

Make sure to use supervision at all times if using scissors.

Snack Time

This pizza themed snack includes both make your own personal pizzas and a yummy dessert pizza for later! Before you start creating, I'd highly recommend asking the children's parents about any restrictions they have with food for the kids, food allergies, etc. I would also suggest putting the ingredients together ahead of time so that you don't have to spend time in the kitchen while you are babysitting. Baking the brownies ahead of time for dessert would also be a great time saver.

Pizzeria Simon Says Game

To play Simon Says, the babysitter reads out the actions and the little ones act them out only if the babysitter first says "Simon Says". For example, if she says "Simon says toss the pizza dough" then the kids act out tossing the pizza dough in the air. If she says "Toss the pizza dough" the kids don't do it because she didn't say "Simon Says" first. Anyone acting out one of the actions without "Simon Says" is out of that round and the last person left acting is the winner for that round. This is even a fun game to play as a babysitter with one child. It's a great way to get some exercise while being totally silly!

Good Behavior Certificate

Were the little ones well behaved while you babysat them? With fun activities to keep them busy, I'm sure you all had a great time together! You can award them for being so good by giving them a good behavior certificate. Feel free to add on your own stickers to personalize it.

Want to keep track of the kits you've completed together? You can use these kit completion certificates to track the kits you've successfully completed.




Create Your Pizza!

Simon Says (in no particular order):

- Toss the pizza dough

- Put on the oven gloves
- Eat the pizza

- Put the toppings on the pizza (Feel free to add your own!)

Personal Pizzas

Ingredients:

Sliced meats:

ham, pepperoni, salami,

sausage, etc.

Sliced veggies:

onion, bell peppers,

olives, mushrooms

Pita Bread

Pizza Tomato Sauce

Shredded Cheese

Optional: Oregano, Parmesan Cheese

Instructions:

Have the kids top their pizza (pitas) with tomato sauce, meat, veggies and shredded cheese.

Pop these into a toaster oven for a few minutes until the cheese starts melting.

Dessert Pizza

Ingredients:

Boxed brownie mix

2 Cups Vanilla instant pudding mix

Sliced fruits:

kiwis, bananas, pineapple, berries,

etc.

Instructions:

Bake the brownie mix according to directions, in a round cake pan.

Once baked and cooled, remove from the pan and place on a platter or large plate.

Top with the vanilla pudding and sliced fruit.

Slice into pizza slices for dessert!
