## Instructions



### MATERIALS:

- Good quality standard 8.5"x11" size sheet / A4 white stock card (suggested 200gsm)
- Full sheet adhesive labels
- Glue or double sided sticky tape
- Scissors and craft knife
- Bone folder and ruler for scoring

### INSTRUCTIONS:

#### **CRAYON BOX**

**STEP 1.** Print the crayon box file on to good quality white stock card.

**STEP 2.** If required score along the fold lines (grey dotted lines) for easier folding.

**STEP 3.** Using a craft knife or scissors carefully cut out the outline shape of the crayon box.

**STEP 4.** Using a craft knife carefully cut out the white area on the front of the box to create a window.

**STEP 5.** Using a craft knife or scissors cut along all of the black dotted lines (marked cut here) this will create the flaps for the top and bottom of the boxes.

**STEP 6.** Fold along all of the fold lines (grey dotted lines).

**STEP 7.** Then glue or tape the section marked (Glue Flap 1) and attach to the back of the section marked (Flap 2) this will create a hollow box shape.

**STEP 8.** Next fold in the small flaps on each corner at the top and bottom of the box.

**STEP 9.** Then fold in the bottom of the box and push the section marked (Bottom Flap) inside the box.

**STEP 10.** Fill the box with crayons and then repeat STEP 9 with the top of the box and close the box by pushing section marked (Top Flap) inside the top of the box.

## **CRAYON WRAPS**

**STEP 1.** Print the crayon wraps on to a full sheet of adhesive labels or standard 8.5"x11" size sheet / A4 sheet white thick paper.

**STEP 2.** Carefully cut out all of the wraps.

**STEP 3.** If printed on adhesive paper carefully remove backing and attach to each crayon or if printed on paper apply glue or double sided tape to the back of the wrap and carefully attach to each crayon.
